### **Before Creating a PDF**

- Proofread your source document thoroughly to confirm that it will require no revision.
- We recommend that you also run a Plagiarism check using a standard software.

### **Creating your PDF eXpress Account**

Log in to the [IEEE PDF eXpress<sup>TM</sup> site](#)

*First-time users should do the following:*

1. Select the New Users - Click Here link.
2. Enter the following:
  - **63970X** for the Conference ID
  - your email address
  - a password
3. Continue to enter information as prompted.

An Online confirmation will be displayed and an email confirmation will be sent verifying your account setup.

*Previous users* of PDF eXpress need to follow the above steps, but should enter the same password that was used for previous conferences. Verify that your contact information is valid.
